

Start with the email you received:

Click on "setting your site's title and tag line"



Create a Page by clicking on






To add a new page, click on "Add New"

- (1) Give your page the title, "Home"
- (2) This is where information about your page will show up on your website
- To hyperlink to a source or another page, use the button.
- (3) You can restrict who sees your information


- (4) Your site will not be seen until it is PUBLISHED
- (5) You can preview your site before it goes public



- I. You can change how your webpage looks by changing the Themes.
 - a. For the time being, I would like you to use the "Misty Lake" Theme so we can work through it together.
 - i. If you are comfortable with this software and want to experiment, please feel free to be creative.
 - ii. You MUST have a site that supports menus (they do NOT need to be custom menus), and that is designed for text, not images.
- II. Now you need to build a series of pages, as outlined in Assignment 1

- a. These pages will be empty you will add content later. Until then, you can use this disclaimer:
 - i. This site is under development, please check back at the end of May for more information.
- b. You need these pages to make a menu.


III. Making a menu



- 1. Select your pages
- 2. Arrange them in the order you want them to appear in
- 3. When you move a page slightly to the right, it will appear as a drop-down page under the "parent"
- 4. Give your new Menu a name (It doesn't matter no one ever sees this, I usually call it Main or Navigation)
- 5. Tell your page which Menu to use

IV. Change the header

- a. There is a huge collection of freely usable images at the Wikimedia Commons http://commons.wikimedia.org/wiki/Main Page
 - i. You must use a non-copywritten image. If you use a copywritten image, you are violating copyright law which is just as bad as plagiarism.
 - ii. Here are 5 more sources to get images from http://www.makeuseof.com/tag/top-5-websites-for-free-stock-photographs/



You will probably need to save the image to your computer to use it. You can also upload media to the site itself if you feel comfortable navigating that...
